

#### Waste statistics



- I'll start with some statistics to show how important our work on this project is. The chart shows that packaging paper and cardboard are 41% of the total waste. Bulgaria is ranked 15<sup>th</sup> with a recycling rate of 62%.

## Roadshows, events and workshops





# Targeted communication campaigns



• At the moment Mezdra Municipality have a system for reducing the garbage fee to citizens with 30% for handing over 70 kilograms of paper for recycling. The problem is that the information for the campaign does not reach enough people and a large proportion of residents miss the deadline for making a statement. That's why we started using "Targeted communication campaigns" by publishing campaign information on all communication channels.
