From the moment the program was implemented, we aimed to find solutions for the problems regarding environmental protection, as well as the quality of life and the health of the population from Mihai Viteazu

- As project partners, we contributed to the development of the <u>incentive systems</u> required to boost the implementation of the best practices regarding paper collection.
- We are involved in the <u>cluster definition and compilation of</u> the information on paper collection from our municipality
- We registered the <u>limitations</u> generated in the modelling of the current systems, as well as in the <u>creation of sustainable</u> <u>collection models and the selection of best practices</u>, in order to align our actions for future implementation with the necessary innovations

Our main thoughts about the project:

- Romania is a country where paper and board still largely ends in residual waste.
- These project aims to help us to understand the importance of PfR and increase the amount of PfR.







Main lessons learned:

- Only analysing the problems of recycling, in the smallest detail, we can define the problems, evaluate ideas an decline to implement the ideas
- We received information about the collection system and instructions how to separate the waste
- We need to implement long-therm education strategy which enables all groups of the population to gain knowledge about recycling
- In Mihai Viteazu the paper of recycling is deficient, we have learned through that we have to take into account the best practices of collecting paper
